An application has been filed on behalf of the accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu, along with a fresh vokalatnama as well as certified copy of the order dated 07-07-2023 passed by the Hon'ble Court in CRM (N.D.P.S) 1122 of 2023, along with an affidavit by the Ld. Counsel, affirming the genuinity of the said copy of order. It is prayed for on behalf of accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu that they be allowed to furnish bail bonds, as directed by the Hon'ble High Court.

Perused the impugned application, as well as the certified copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble Court.

Heard.

It appears that the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased to order as follows :

“....., the petitioners, shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of 10,000/- each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of Ld. Judge, Special Court under N.D.P.S Act, Howrah, subject to condition that they shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever. In the event they fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail automatically without reference to this court.

It is manifest from the record that Hon'ble Court has been pleased to grant bail to the accused persons and they have filed an application intending to furnish bail bond in terms of the order passed by the Hon'ble Court.

The prayer is considered and allowed. The accused persons are liberty to furnish bond, as has been stipulated by the Hon'ble Court.

One Kabita Samanta appears before the court and files two separate registered gift deeds being nos. I-050602343/2023, dated 23-05-2023 and I-050601682/2023 dated 18-04-2023, along with record of rights of accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu respectively. The said Kabita Samanta also files two separate affidavits before Judicial Magistrate, 4th Class, Howrah in respect of accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu respectively, affirming the genuinity of the said deeds. The said Kabita Samanta also files two separate bail bonds as local security on behalf of accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu.

Asit Jati and Arif Hossain Khan file bonds of behalf of the accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu as registered securities respectively. The said bail bonds appear to have been duly checked and fitted by the bail bond officer.

Perused the same, as well as other materials on record.

Heard the Ld. Counsel Mr. Sanglap Mukherjee, appearing on behalf of accused persons.

The bail bonds by the local security Kabita Samanta, depositing registered deeds nos. I-050602343/2023, dated 23-05-2023 and I-050601682/2023 dated 18-04-2023, of ADSR, Bagnan, Howrah are found sufficient and hence accepted.

The bail bonds filed by two registered securities Asit Jati and Arif Hossain Khan appear to have checked and fitted by the bail bond officer and hence the same accepted as well.

The accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu appear to have satisfied this court regarding the bail bonds that the Hon'ble Court have directed him to furnish before this court in CRM (NDPS) 1122 of 2023. As such, release him at once.

Issue release order in respect of accused persons, namely Abid Hasan @ Bablu and Salim Mollah @ Azu @ Atu directing the correctional home authorities to forthwith release the accused persons from custody, if they are not wanted in any other case.
