Heard. The instant application has been filed by the applicant/accused named above under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, submitting that he is an innocent person and has been falsely implicated in this case by the police.

2. The present case arising out of FIR no. 167 dated 25.06.2019, u/s 22 NDPS Act, P.S. Dera, has been registered against applicant/accused on the allegations that he was found in possession of 14 strips of Spasmo Proxyvon Plus capsules (total 112 capsules) and 05 strips of Lomotil tablets (total 300 tablets) on 25.06.2019 whereas, report of chemical examiner has not been received. The applicant/accused is already in judicial lock-up since the date of arrest i.e. 25.06.2019. Recovery has already been effected. Completion of investigation and presentation of challan may take its own time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant further in judicial lock-up.

3. Resultantly, the present application is allowed and the

applicant-accused is ordered to be released **on interim bail** subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, with the conditions that the applicant shall appear in the trial Court on each and every date of hearing ; shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall not leave limits of India except with the prior permission of the trial Court and further **subject to result of the report of Chemical Examiner.**

4. Bail papers be consigned to record room.
