

Harpinder Singh @ Harbhinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab.

Learned Public Prosecutor has placed on the file report of SHO, Police Station Civil Lines, Batala to the effect that Rekha Kumari, the wife of the applicant, has moved two applications against the applicant and his parents and the said applications are being inquired into. However, no FIR has been registered in the matter so far.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that police may be directed to serve prior notice upon the applicant before effecting his arrest in case any FIR is registered against the applicant on the basis of said complaints. However, this Court is of the view that no such direction can be issued. In fact, application is pre-mature. In the event of registration of FIR, the police would obviously proceed further as per Sections 41 and 41(A) of the Cr.P.C, if applicable to the facts of the case. With these observations, the instant application is hereby declined. File be consigned to the Record Room.
