Electricity Case no. 290 of 2024

Order No.02 dated 25-09-2024

The record is put up on the prayer of accused person. Accused/petitioner namely Shankar Adhikary surrenders before the court today. He is taken into custody and remanded to J.C. An application for bail is filed on behalf of accused person.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the State is present.

The record is taken up for hearing on the application for bail.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused person submits that above stated accused person is the beneficiary of the registered consumer Panchanan Adhikary under CESC Ltd, and the accused is named in FIR, and the allegation is that they committed pilferage of electricity from the electric connection of existing meter. He submits that final assessment bill of Rs.69233/- towards unauthorized use of electricity has already been deposited to the CESC authority. He prays for enlarging the petitioner/accused person on bail, on any condition.

Ld. PP in charge on behalf of the State does not oppose the bail prayer.

Perused the materials on record.

It appears that appears that an amount of Rs.69233/- in respect of unauthorized use of electricity has been deposited to the CESC authority by the accused person in the account of the consumer. It is seen that CESC authority has settled the accused person as the beneficiary of the registered consumer Panchanan Adhikary (reference no.-LBB/01971/2024 dated 10-09-2024 Annexure-A).

In view of above, the prayer for enlarging the petitioner/accused on bail, is considered and allowed. The said accused person may be released from custody on furnishing bail bond of Rs.1,000/- with one registered surety of like amount id to J/C.

To date (29-10-2025) for appearance of the accused person, if bail bond is furnished, and IO's report.
