Today is fixed for compliance report of the bank and further order.

The Judgment Debtor/Insurance Company appears through its learned advocate and files a copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in New India Assurance Company Vs. Malati Patra and Ors. in FMAT (MV) 532 of 2025 with IA No. CAN/1/2026 and CAN/2/2026 in connection with M.A.C. Case no 69 of 2009, along with a money receipt/treasury challan contending that the amount has already been deposited in terms of the order of the Hon'ble High Court.

The learned advocate for the Judgment Debtor further submits that, in view of the deposit made pursuant to the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, the order of attachment of the bank account of the Judgment Debtor is liable to be recalled.

The decree holder prays for time for verification of the documents filed by the Judgment debtor Insurance Company.

Perused the documents filed. The Tribunal is not fully satisfied about the compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court in its letter and spirit.

Accordingly, let the matter be fixed on **05-08-2026** for further hearing.

However this tribunal taking note of the prima facie satisfaction of the order of the Hon'ble Court as mentioned above, temporarily suspends the operation and effect of the order of attachment passed earlier by this court vide order no 4 dated 09.02.26 and order no 8 dated 16-06-26 till next date of hearing.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Manager of the concerned bank (HDFC Bank, Stephen House, 4, B.B.D Bag East, Kolkata-700001) for information and compliance.

Let there be temporary stay of all further proceeding subject to the satisfaction of the compliance of the order of the Hon'ble High Court.
