State Vs. Iqbal Singh

Present: Sh. Kuldeep Singh, Ld.APP for state.
Accused on bail with counsel Sh.KD Sharma, Advocate.

No evidence of the prosecution is present. Ld. APP for the State has further requested for an adjournment, which is strongly opposed by Ld. Counsel for the accused. Perusal of the case file reveals that all the material witnesses have been examined by the prosecution in the present case. Therefore, this Court does not find a fit ground for further adjournment of the present case. Accordingly, evidence of the prosecution is closed by order.

Statement of accused U/s 313 recorded.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate detailed judgment of even date, the accused Iqbal Singh stands **acquitted** of the charge under Sections 279 & 304-A IPC framed against him. His bail bonds and surety bonds are hereby discharged if any.

Accused is directed to furnish requisite bonds under section 437-A Cr.P.C in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Requisite personal bonds furnished which have been accepted and attested and cash surety in the shape of FDR deposited by the accused. Intimation be sent to the concerned bank to the effect that the amount mentioned in the FDR shall not be released to the accused without prior permission of this Court. Copy of order be sent to the concerned bank for necessary compliance. File be completed and consigned to Judicial Record Room after due compliance.
