Order No.33 dated 26-06-2025

Today is fixed for appearance, production, and hearing of bail petition dated 12-06-2025 on behalf of accused Juli Kumari, and hearing of the petition dated 15-05-2025 filed by the prosecution, and written objection(s), if any.

Out of seven accused persons, two accused persons namely Neha Sonthalia, and Vijay Sonthalia, on court bail, are present by filing hazira.

Three female accused persons namely Juli Kumari, Mukul Bag @ Sarkar, and Jyotsna Mondal in J/C, are physically produced today from Alipore Womens' Correctional Home.

Rest two accused persons namely Manik Halder, and Shourav Adhikary, both in J/C, are produced physically produced today from Howrah District Correctional Home.

Ld. P.P-in-charge is present and so the Ld. Advocates for the accused persons of this case.

Hence, the record is taken up for hearing of the bail petition dated 12-06-2025 filed on behalf of the accused Juli Kumari.

Ld. Advocate for the accused Juli Kumari submits that this accused is in custody since the last 150 days and no serious allegations have been found against her, for which she is entitled to get bail. He has prayed for necessary order.

Ld. P.P-in-charge raises vehement objection to the bail petition being allowed and prays for passing necessary order.

The record shows that the bail petition of this accused Juli Kumari has once been rejected vide Order no.4 dated 15-05-2025 on the ground that allegations against this accused person are critical in nature and there appears prima facie involvement of this accused in the offences so charged against her. Today, no cogent reason has arisen so to enlarge the accused on bail and it is lucid from the materials on the record and in the CD that there have been no change in circumstances for granting bail to her.

Accordingly, the bail petition dated 12-06-2025 of accused Juli Kumari is rejected.

Today, accused Vijay Santhalia files a petition stating that he was enlarged on bail by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta and that the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to confirm his interim bail vide Order dated 18-06-2025, passed in C.R.M (DB) 124 of 2025 with CRAN No.1 of 2025. He has prayed for passing necessary order.

Perusal of the server copy of the order dated 18-06-2025, passed in C.R.M (DB) 124 of 2025 with CRAN No.1 of 2025 by the Hon'ble Court reveals that the interim bail granted earlier to the accused Vijay Sonthalia has been confirmed. Let this fact be noted on record.

So, the petition filed by the accused Vijay Sonthalia today is accordingly disposed of.

Therefore, the record is now taken up for hearing of the petition dated 15-05-2026 filed by the prosecution.

No written objections are filed by the accused persons. As such, heard Ld. P.P-in-charge in respect of the concerned petition, in part today.

It is now 5:00 p.m. and due to paucity of time, case is adjourned today.

Hence, fixing 14-07-2025 (1:00 p.m.) for appearance of the accused persons on bail, production of the accused persons in J/C; and for further hearing of the prosecution's petition dated 15-05-2025.
