SURENDRA PAL RANA Vs. HEMANT KUMAR

Present: Ld. counsel for DH through VC with son of DH.  
None for JD.

Warrants of possession and attachment have come back duly executed. Counsel for DH, on instructions, submits that DH has already received possession of the property in question. He further submits that the entire decretal amount also stands paid by the JD to DH. He submits that thus, the entire decree under execution covered by relief (i) and (ii) stands satisfied. The said submission is taken on record. He submits that the execution may be disposed off as satisfied and any attachment against the movable assets of the JD may be vacated.
