Order No. 2 Dated: 23.02.2024

The accused persons, namely **Binod Kumar, Biswanath Das, Gora Khan, Sangram Panda @ Shibu and Salman Molkla** are produced from P.C.

The accused persons are taken into custody.

The I/O is present along with the C.D.

The I/O files a prayer for remanding the accused **Gora Khan, Sangram Panda @ Shibu and Salman Molkla** for judicial custody.

No prayer for bail on behalf of the accused persons have been filed.

The investigation is at nascent stage. The accused persons have been implicated for commission an offence punishable u/s. 20(b)(ii) (C)/29 of the NDPS Act. Considering the fact that contraband of commercial quantity has been recovered from the possession of the accused persons, coupled with the embargo upon the court in granting bail u/s. 37 of the NDPS Act, together with other incriminating materials against the accused persons, the accused persons are remanded to J.C till 07.03.2024.

The I/O files a prayer for extension police custody remand further for 07 days of the two accused persons **Binod Kumar and Biswanath Das** of this case.

Seen the prayer of IO with recommendation of Assistant Commissioner of Police, South I, Howrah who prays for allowing seven (07) days police remand of the accused persons namely **Binod Kumar and Biswanath Das**.

Ld. P.P. Incharge is present.

CD is produced. IO is present. Heard I/O.

Perused the CD and the forwarding report duly forwarded by Assistant Commissioner of Police, South I, Howrah. The prayer for further PC for seven (07) days is for causing further recovery of contraband substance as well as for apprehension of the other persons involved in the alleged offence.

It is manifest from the CD that 113 kgs 100 gms of ganja, has been recovered from the possession of the accused persons. The investigation agency believes that further recovery can be made on the basis of disclosure

made by the accused before the police. Considering the incriminating materials in the CD and the submission of the I/O I am of the view that prayer for PC should be allowed for six **(06)** days. Accordingly, the prayer for PC for six (06) days is allowed.

IO is directed to ensure that utmost care and caution be taken by Police personnel and the accused persons are not man handled in any manner whatsoever and to provide him with all possible medical assistance if needed, during the period of police remand. The accused must be taken for medical check up on each day during police remand.

IO is further directed to strictly observe the guidelines set out by our Hon'ble Apex Court regarding police custody of accused.

Inform IO.

To 29.02.2024 for production of accused persons **Binod Kumar and Biswanath Das** positively at 10.30 AM with P.C report.

Return CD to IO.

Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the Assistant Commissioner of Police, South I, Howrah and I/O of this case for information and taking necessary action.
