CHARGE WITH THREE HEADS
{No. XXVIII(II) Schedule V. Act V.1898}
(Sections 221,222,223 Code of Criminal Procedure)

1. Name and office of the Judge : Somesh Prasad Sinha,

I, do hereby charge you : Sanjay Sharma

as follows :- **Firstly**, that since you meet the de facto complainant Tulika Banerjee d/o Samaresh Banerjee of Paulpara PO- Ghoshpara, Howrah subject her to make physical relation with her by making the fake promises that you will marry her and in that belief she did not stop you to make such relation and that you thereby committed an offence punishable u/s 493 of the IPC and within the cognizance of this court.

And I do hereby direct that you be tried on the said charge.

Secondly, that you, on 26.01.2013 when the parents of de facto complainant was absent in their house, you came to her house and forcefully raped her and you thereby committed an offence punishable u/s 376 of the IPC and within the cognizance of this court.

And I do hereby direct that you be tried on the said charge.

Thirdly, that you, after meeting Tulika Banerjee, de facto complainant, by making fake promises that you will marry her and for that reason you make physical relation with her several times but you did not tell her that you are married and suppressing the truth, you exploit the de facto complainant sexually and cheated her and you thereby committed an offence punishable u/s 417 of the IPC and within the cognizance of this court.

And I do hereby direct that you be tried on the said charge.

The contents of the charges so framed are read over and explained to the accused person in Bengali Language to which he pleads not guilty and claims to be tried.
