ORDER

1. File put up before me being Duty Judge as learned
Presiding Officer is availing summer vacation.
2. This order of mine shall dispose of above mentioned bail
application moved by petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
3. The case of the prosecution is that on 09/05/2021, at
about 08.35 PM, in the area of village Kala Bala, 6 grams heroin and
one revolver .32 Bore along 6 live cartridges of .32 Bore were
recovered from petitioner Sajanpreet Singh alias Sajan and 4 grams

heroin was recovered from co-accused Madan Masih. Petitioner was arrested and since then he is in custody.

4. Upon notice, learned Additional P. P. put in appearance and contested the bail application. Police record was requisitioned and perused.

5. I have heard the arguments of learned counsel for petitioners as well as of learned Additional Public Prosecutor and perused the record.

6. Petitioner is in custody since 09/05/2021 for the alleged recovery of 6 grams heroin and one revolver .32 Bore along 6 live cartridges of .32 Bore were recovered from co-accused Sajanpreet Singh alias Sajan. Above quantity of heroin falls in the category of non commercial quantity. Conclusion of investigation and presentation of challan will take sufficient long time. No purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars for indefinite period, as such, present application is hereby allowed and petitioner is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-

- i. That he shall not hinder the ongoing investigation;
- ii. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
- iii. That he shall not make any threat, promise or inducement to any person conversant with the facts of the case to dissuade him/her from disclosing the truth to the

Court or police;

Bonds not furnished. Copy of this order be attached with remand papers. Record of bail application be sent to the concerned court for consignment.
