ORDER:

1. The present order of mine shall dispose of an application for bail under Section 483 BNS moved on behalf of applicant/accused Major Singh, in FIR No. 135 Dated 1611.2024, registered under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 3,5,118(2),238 BNS, at Police Station Bhindi Saidan,Amritsar.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP attached to this Court alongwith copy of

bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Record was also summoned which has been received and perused. On 15.4.2025 ASI Gurdev Singh appeared and suffered statement to the effect that victim Ajit Kaur mother of the complainant received grievous injuries as per medical record, whereupon offence u/s.118(2) BNS was added vide rapat no.14 of 28.12.2024. it is further submitted that applicant was armed with datar, who has been arrested in this case on 28.12.2024. He further stated that investigation is complete and challan has been presented before the Court. As per their record, no other case is found registered against applicant-accused.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant-accused is innocent and is behind the bars since 29.12.204. He has been involved falsely in the present case due to enmity and that applicant has not committed any offence. It is further submitted that presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time. It is further submitted that regular bail application of applicant has been dismissed by the Court of Id. JMIC, Ajnala on 10.3.2025. Accordingly, learned counsel for the applicant/accused prayed that regular bail be granted to the applicant/accused.

4. In oppugnation, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State contested the bail application while submitting that simple and grievous injuries have been caused by applicant and co-accused upon Ajit Kaur mother of the complainant, also with sharp edged weapons. It

is argued that the allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature, therefore, he is not entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail and learned Addl.P.P. implored for dismissal of the bail application.

5. I have heard the rival contentions and have also gone through the relevant record with the able assistance of the learned counsel for the applicant and [learned Addl. PP for the State](#)

6. The FIR has been got registered on the statement of complainant Onkar Singh on the allegations that on 13.11.2024 his younger brother Bagha Singh had some scuffle with Major Singh applicant due to some previous enmity and in this context his mother Ajit Kaur had gone to their house on 14.11.2024 to complain and when she was coming back, complainant was also coming behind her and he found that Major Singh applicant-accused armed with datar alongwith non applicants armed with weapons had encircled his mother Ajit Kaur and started giving random blows of weapons to her which hit her on her both arms and legs and other parts of the body. As per medical record of victim Ajit Kaur she has sustained 07 injuries o her person out of which injuries no.1,2,3 and 5 were inflicted with sharp edged weapon and thereafter injury no.1 was declared grievous in nature. Applicant-accused was armed with deadly weapon alongwith his co-accused caused several simple and grievous injuries to victim Jito aged about 50 years. During investigation offence under Section 118(2) of BNS was added vide rapat no.14 dated 28.12.2024. Keeping in view the enormity of the offence and that there are specific and grave allegations against

applicant-accused alongwith his companions for committing the offence of causing injuries Ajit Kaur alias Jito mother of the complainant. Thus, the allegations levelled against the applicant-accused are serious. Therefore, the possibility of applicant/accused intimidating the witnesses in case he is released on bail, cannot be ruled out. Thus, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the accused/applicant.

7. Resultantly, without commenting upon any expression on merits, the present bail application filed by applicant/accused Major Singh stands dismissed. Record received from the Court of Id. Illaqa Magistrate be returned forthwith alongwith copy of this order. Present bail application file be consigned to the Record Room after its due compilation.
