ORDER:-

Record produced by the prosecution agency. Heard on bail application filed by applicant/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Guri. As per the affidavit attached with the bail application, this is the first bail application of applicant/accused.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to State and Investigating Officer was called alongwith record. SC Surjit Singh appeared and submitted that he came alongwith record of bail pertaining to the abovestated case and in FIR no. 97 dated 11.06.2026 registered under Section 303(2), 317(2) of BNS, PS City Dhuri. Date of arrest of accused Gurpreet Singh @ Guri is on 11.06.2026.

3. Learned defence counsel argued that applicant/accused is innocent and false case has been planted upon accused. Accused is in custody since 11.06.2026. He argued that presentation of challan will take time and as such, accused be granted the concession of bail.

4. I have perused the record. Applicant/accused Gurpreet Singh @ Guri was arrested on 11.06.2026. Recovery has already been effected from co-accused. Accused/applicant Gurpreet Singh @ Guri is already in judicial custody. Presentation of challan and conclusion thereof shall take sufficient long time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind bars. Moreover, keeping the accused in jail will be a burden on the State Exchequer.

Accordingly, the bail application of accused is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:-

1. That applicant/accused shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.

2. The applicant/accused shall not leave India without prior approval of this Court.

3. The applicant/accused shall not tamper with the evidence and shall not threat, induce etc. the witness of prosecution.

4. The applicant/accused shall not commit any similar offence in future.

5. Bail bonds/surety bonds not furnished. In view of the directions of Honourable Supreme Court in **Re: Policy Strategy for Grant of Bail, SUO MOTO (Cri.) No.4 of 2021 order dated 31.01.2023**, Ahlmad is directed to forward copy of this order to concerned Superintendent of Jail for the intimation to the concerned accused/applicant. Papers be attached with the main case file/remand papers.
