A report from Deputy Superintendent of Police Moga is received that one application no.384-F/21 dated 10.08.2021 moved by one Rajwinder Kaur daughter of Surjit Singh, resident of Kot Ise Khan is pending against the applicants-accused, in which she has leveled allegations regarding harassing and maltreating her by the applicants-accuse, who are sister-in-law (nanad) and her husband, for demands of dowry, however, no FIR has been registered against the applicants-accused.

2. Heard. Keeping in view the above said report, since no FIR is registered against the applicants, instant bail application is ordered to be dismissed having become infructuous. However, in future in case any FIR is registered against the applicants-accused, on the basis of above said application within two months, then three days prior notice be issued to them before their arrest.
