ORDER

File put up before me being Duty Judge as learned Presiding Officer has gone to avail summer vacations from 01.06.2026 to 15.06.2026.

2. Vide this order, I shall dispose of the bail application under section 483 of B.N.S.S moved by accused/applicant. Record received and perused. Statement of ASI Ashok Kumar, who has brought the record pertaining to the bail application, has been recorded separately.

3. As per allegations of the prosecution, on 01.05.2026, in the area of police station Mehna, present applicant/accused Ajit Singh alias Hans was apprehended by the police party headed by ASI Nahar Singh, when police party

was on patrolling and he was found in conscious possession of 5 grams of Heroin along with 22 loose intoxicating tablets.

4. The chemical report has not yet been received. Without receiving the chemical report, it cannot be ascertained that salt of contraband recovered from the possession of the applicant/accused falls under the category of commercial or non-commercial quantity. The present accused/applicant is in custody since the date of his arrest i.e. 01.05.2026. So, in view of the judgment passed by the **Hon'ble High Court in Criminal Misc. No M-1379 of 2013 in case titled as Ravinder Singh @ Rinku vs. State of Punjab**, interim bail is granted to the accused/applicant on furnishing of personal bonds to the tune of **Rs.50,000/-** with one surety in the like amount, with the condition that he will surrender before the Court positively if contents of salt of intoxicant substance falls under the category of commercial in nature. Accordingly, bail application under reference stands disposed off.

Police record be returned. File be sent back to court concerned.
