Today is fixed for framing of issues.

The claimant and the contesting OP no. 2 file their respective haziras.

At this stage, the claimant files a petition under Order 1 Rule 10 (2) read with section 151 of the CPC. Copy of the same has been served.

Hence, the instant petition is heard at length, in full.

By filing the said petition, the claimant submitted that at the time of filing of this case, due to inadvertent mistake, the four minor daughters of the deceased victim were not made parties to this case as his legal heirs and hence, the instant petition has been filed to add such daughters, namely Afrin Khatoon (13 years), Alima Parveen (11 years), Jasmin Parveen (8 years) and Falak Khatun (6 years) as parties to this case for fair disposal of the same, being duly represented by their natural guardian and mother Reshma Khatun, i.e., the present claimant.

Ld. Advocate for the claimant submitted at the time of hearing that the said daughters were not added as claimants in this case at the time of its filing due to mistake, and he then prayed for passing necessary order in this regard. The Ld. Advocate for the contesting OP no. 2 does not raise any objection to the instant petition being allowed and he too, prays for passing the necessary order.

Upon careful examination of the instant petition, it is evident that it has been filed in good faith and is duly supported by an affidavit. Also, the inclusion of these four daughters as parties in this case is crucial for the proper adjudication of the matter and for reaching a comprehensive understanding of the issues involved. In light of these considerations, I am of the firm view that the present petition warrants to be allowed.

Accordingly, the petition under Order 1 Rule 10 (2) read with section 151 of the CPC filed by the claimant today is allowed on consent.

Also, let the four minor daughters, namely Afrin Khatoon (13 years), Alima Parveen (11 years), Jasmin Parveen (8 years) and Falak Khatun (6 years) be arrayed as the claimant nos. 2 to 5 respectively, in this case, being duly represented by their natural guardian and mother Reshma Khatun.

Let necessary notes be made accordingly in the CIS and all concerned registers.

Claimant is to file the amended claim application on the next date fixed, containing the details of the added minor daughters therein.

Fixing **25.02.2026** for filing amended claim petition by the claimant.
