Contested Challan received from the Virtual Traffic Courts web portal. Let it be verified and registered.

Fresh vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the violator. The same has been taken on record.

Challan taken up today on an oral request of early hearing.

1. The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the virtual court and fine was proposed for summary disposal of case as per Section 208 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic for further adjudication as per law.

2. At this stage, accusation is explained to the violator in vernacular language. Violator submits that he wishes to plead guilty for the offence u/s 115/194(1) of Motor Vehicles Act of 1988. Violator is apprised about the consequences of pleading guilty. Violator submits that he has understood the consequences and wishes to plead guilty.

3. Heard. Perused. Considered.

4. Keeping in view the plea of guilt of offence by the violator, violator **is convicted of offence u/s 115/194(1) of Motor Vehicles Act of 1988. Violator is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- and in default simple imprisonment of 7 days.**

5. Violator is directed to pay the fine amount of Rs. 10,000/- on the web portal of the court i.e. <https://pay.ecourts.gov.in>.

Put up for verification of payment on **25.01.2025**.
