1. My this order will dispose of an application under section 439 of the CrPC submitted by applicant/ accused Bhanu son of Janmej Singh

2. Notice of the bail application is given to the State.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor contested the bail application.

4. On the other hand Learned counsel for the applicant / accused argued that accused is in custody since 27.10.2018. Challan has been presented. The completion of trial will take long time. He be granted the bail.

5. From the submissions of learned counsel for the applicant/accused, learned Additional Public prosecutor for the State and perusal of the file, it is clear that accused Bhanu Partap assured the complainant that he will get a job for Rakesh Kumar and took the amount of ₹ 3 lakh. The accused is in custody since 27.10.2018. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Therefore

accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Ilqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate Pathankot court subject to the condition that he will appear before the court on each and every date of hearing, he will not leave the country without prior permission of the court and he will not influence the witnesses and in case of any misuse of concession of bail, both the accused as well as surety shall be liable for the consequences as per law. Copy of this order be sent to the Ilqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate Pathankot for necessary compliance. Bail application file be consigned tot he records.
