ORDER

This is an application filed by the applicant/accused No.23
for renewal of passport.

2. Perused the application and say.

3. Heard both the sides.

4. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant/accused No.23 that in the present matter, after completing investigation, charge-sheet came to be filed. The present applicant/accused was released on bail by order dated 15.06.2018. During investigation, passport of the present applicant/accused was seized and in view of order dated 24.06.2019 passed below application (Exhibit-26), passport of the present applicant was returned to the applicant.

5. It is submitted that the passport of the present applicant has expired on 24.03.2024 and the same needs to be renewed for the purpose of travelling outside India with prior permission of this court. Already the applicant had travelled to USA by taking permission vide order dated 23.06.2023. As there is condition imposed that he shall not travel without prior permission of the court, hence, prayed to issue no objection for renewal of passport.

6. Learned APP opposed the application on the ground that the present applicant has committed serious offence. He intentionally with knowledge participated in the crime. If his passport of the applicant is renewed, then repetition of crime cannot be ruled out. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

7. Considering the submissions, the learned counsel for the applicant/accused relied upon the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Mahesh Kumar Agarwal Vs. Union of India (Civil Appeal arising out of SLP (Civil) No.17769 of 2025)**.

8. In the present matter, there is a condition that the applicant shall not travel abroad without prior permission of the court and before this also, he travelled with prior permission of the court. In this application, the applicant is seeking only renewal of passport. Therefore, he is entitled for the same. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:-

ORDER

1. The application (Exhibit-72) is hereby allowed.
2. The applicant/accused No.23-Sohail Abdul Razzak Patni is entitled for renewal of his Passport bearing No. L8088382.
3. The Regional Passport Office, Mumbai to renew the Passport bearing No. L8088382 of the applicant-Sohail Abdul Razzak Patni for the normal period of 10 years in accordance with law.
4. The application (Exhibit-72) in Sessions Case No.261/2018 stands disposed off accordingly.
