Record is put up today by way of put up petition.

Put up is allowed.

The Ld. APP is present.

The accused has filed a petition praying for guilty.

Perused the case record specially the charge sheet under section-173 Cr.P.C., 1973.

Considering the case record, specially the charge sheet under section-173 Cr.P.C., 1973, it appears that there is prima facie material to frame charge against the accused under section- 411 of IPC.

Accordingly the charge is framed in the prescribed form under the said section. The charge so framed is read over and explained to the accused person and asked whether he wants to plead guilty or have any defence to make, to which the accused pleaded guilty by saying “Ami doshi”. Let the form of the charge be kept with the record.

This court accept his plea having satisfied that the accused accepted guilt after knowing and understanding it's true import. Accordingly the said accused person is convicted under section 241 - Cr.P.C., 1973. This court heard the accused on the point of conviction and also heard the convict regarding the punishment of the offence, who pleaded mercy.

Hence it is,

**ORDERED**

that the accused person Shib Sankar Singh is found guilty under section 241 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the offence punishable under section 411 of IPC and is punished with simple imprisonment for a term of 47 days and is directed to pay fine of Rs. 500/- i/d to suffer further imprisonment of 1 days.

It transpires from the record that the accused person is in custody since from 14.05.2010 to 29.06.2010 i.e., 47 days.

The period for which the accused has been in custody shall be set off with the period for which he is convicted.

The seized articles, if any, be disposed of in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the case is thus disposed of.
