ORDER

ASI Hardeep Singh has brought the police record.

2. This common order of mine shall dispose of two regular bail applications filed on behalf of the accused/applicant Lovepreet Singh @ Kala and Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi on the ground that they have been falsely implicated in the present case and both are in custody since 10.06.2022. Accused/applicant Lovepreet Singh @ Kala was found in conscious possession of electrical weighing machine for the purpose of weighing the narcotic substance whereas accused/applicant Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi was found in conscious possession of 10 grams heroin. Both the

accused/applicant are deemed to be in conscious possession of 10 grams of heroin.

3. It is contended by learned counsel for the accused/applicants that both the accused/applicant are in custody since 10.06.2022. Small substance has allegedly been recovered from their possession. The challan in the present case has not been presented till today. Challan is likely to take time to be presented. Accused/applicant may be released on regular bail.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State has opposed the regular bail applications on the ground that the accused/applicants are habitual and in case released on regular bail they will be indulged into same activity and will sell the narcotic substance etc. to the general public.

5. After having gone through the record and after hearing learned counsel for the applicant and ld. APP for the State this court is of the opinion that at this stage, this court has to ensure that the both the accused appear before the learned trial court as and when the challan is presented. There is paucity of chemical examiner laboratories. Presentation of challan is likely to take time and no useful purpose shall be served by keeping them further detention. Substance is more than small quantity but less than non-commercial quantity. As such, they are ordered to be released regular bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each. Copy of this order be attached with the connected file. Files are ordered to be consigned tagged with the remand papers.
