BAIL ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of regular bail application moved by the applicant-accused Paramjeet Kaur in this case bearing FIR No.229 of 19.11.2019, U/s 15-61-85 NDPS Act, P.S Bhikhi, District Mansa, wherein it is submitted that the applicant/accused is innocent and

has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing incriminating was recovered from his possession. The allegations raised by the prosecution are false and concocted one. She was arrested on 19.11.2019 and since then, she is in judicial custody and is no more required for further investigation. The presentation of challan is likely to take some time. On the above said submissions, it has been prayed that applicant/accused be released on regular bail.

2. Upon notice, Ld. Addl. PP appeared for State and opposed the bail application on the ground that the offence committed by the accused is serious in nature and is not entitled for concession of regular bail.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused, learned Addl. PP for the State and have gone the police record carefully.

4. As per the FIR, the applicant/accused accused was apprehended on the basis of suspicion by the police party headed by ASI Deep Singh and from his conscious possession, 400 gram poppy husk was recovered. She could not produce any license or permit for keeping the same in his possession. She is in custody since 19.11.2019. The alleged recovery falls in small quantity. The applicant-accused is not required for further investigation of the case. The presentation of challan and its disposal thereof is likely to take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind the bar. Therefore, the applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail in this case on her furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the

like amount to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, with the conditions that:-

1. she shall appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
2. she will not leave India without prior permission of the court;
3. she shall not tamper with the evidence of prosecution.

The bail application is allowed accordingly. Police record be returned.
File be attached with the remand papers.
