

MVC 8220/2025

The IA No.3 filed by the petitioner u/s 6 rule 17 r/w 151 of CPC by praying for permission to amend the petition by correcting the name of the petitioner No.4.

In the affidavit annexed to the application the petitioner submitted that, due to mistake the name of the 4th petitioner in cause title is mentioned as Yellarthi Sai Leela @ Y Sai Leela S/o Late. Narashimappa instead of D/o late. Yallarathi Ramakrishnappa. Hence prays to allow the application by permitting him to amend the petition as sought in the IA.

The purpose of seeking amendment is to correct the name of the petitioner No.4. The Aadhar card of the petitioner No.4 also reveals the name of petitioner No.4 as D/o. Late. Yellarthi Ramakrishnappa.

This shows that these mistake is typographical mistake and needs to be corrected for proper adjudication of the case. By allowing the amendment subject to proof of the same, no prejudice is going to be caused to the opposite party. The new cause of action or new nature of the petition is not going to be introduced by allowing the amendment.

Hence, the IA No.3 is allowed and the petitioner is permitted to amend the petition as sought in the IA.

Amendment is duly carried out and also amended petition is filed.
