The application u/S.483 BNSS arising out of Belur P.S. Case No. 234 of 2024 dated 19.11.2024 u/Ss. 310(4)/310(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioners namely, 1] Md Guddu @ Maxi & 2] Sohail Alam, is taken up for hearing.

The accused/petitioners have stated on affidavit that no application has been filed or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioners submitted that the accused/petitioners are in custody from 20.06.2026 and no incriminating materials were seized from their possession and it is prayed to enlarge them on bail.

Ld.P.P appearing for the State placed the C.D and opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the record it appears that this case relates to the alleged offences punishable u/Ss. 310(4)/310(5) of BNS and it appears from the FIR that the present petitioners are not named in the FIR and they were arrested subsequently and it appears from the C.D. that their names have been transpired in course of the interrogation of other accused.

On perusal of the materials lying in the C.D., I do not find any incriminating materials against the present petitioners. Accordingly, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail.

Hence, it is

Ordered -

that the application under section 483 of BNSS filed by the accused/petitioners is considered and allowed.

The accused/petitioners namely, 1] Md Guddu @ Maxi & 2] Sohail Alam may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs.2,000/- each with two regd. sureties of Rs.1,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M, Howrah with condition to meet the I.O twice in a week till submission of the charge sheet.

C.D and T.C.R be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. C.J.M, Howrah for information and taking necessary action.
