Order No.05 dated 18.08.2026.

The application u/S.482 BNSS arising out of Shyampur P.S. Case No. 325 of 2026 dated 13.06.2026 u/Ss.126(2)/117(2)/118(1)/118(2)/351(3)/3(5) of BNS filed by the accused/petitioners namely, Astami Das @ Astomi, is taken up for hearing.

The petitioners have stated on affidavit that no application has been pending or rejected before or by the Hon'ble High Court till date.

At the time of hearing Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners has not pressed the application for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioner no.1.

Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of accused/petitioner namely, 1) Shambhu Das, is rejected being not pressed.

Perused the petition and the C.D. Heard both sides.

The present case has been initiated alleging assault upon the victim/injured over a matter of family dispute.

Heard the Ld. Defense Counsel who has submitted that there is case and counter case bearing Shyampur PS Case No.364 dated 28.06.2026 over the self-same incident and the accused person also sustained injuries arising from the alleged incident and the petitioner/ accused person is a local woman having no chance of absconding and she will cooperate with the investigation agency and as such, she may be enlarged on bail by imposing any condition. The Ld. Counsel has placed some documents in support of his submission regarding existence of counter case and injuries of the accused person arising from the self-same incident.

Heard Ld. P.P appearing who has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the existence of case and counter case taking note of the fact that the victim/injured has been discharged from the hospital after due treatment, this Court is of the view that custodial interrogation of the petitioner/ accused person, Astami Das @ Astomi does not appear to be necessary.

Hence, it is

Ordered -

that the application under section 482 of BNSS filed by the petitioner/ accused, Astami Das @ Astomi is considered and allowed.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest accused/petitioner Astami Das @ Astomi, shall be released forthwith on furnishing bond of Rs.2,000/- with two regd. Surety of Rs.1,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and on condition as laid down under Section 482(2) BNSS and to meet with the IO once in a fortnight in broad daylight till submission of the charge sheet.

C.D and T.C.R be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.

Let a copy of the order be sent to the Ld. A.C.J.M., Uluberia for information and taking necessary action.
