

Misc Case no.- 223 of 2024

Order dated 30.01.2025

Record is fixed today for filing of show cause by the opposite party no. 1 to 4 and appearance of opposite party no. 5 to 8.

Petitioner is present by filing hazira.

Today Opposite party no. 1 files a show cause petition supported by an affidavit, which is accepted.

Opposite party no. 2,3 & 4 neither filed any show cause nor took any proper steps.

Accordingly, the Misc. Case be fixed for exparte against the Opposite party no. 2,3 & 4.

Today, Opposite party no. 1 files a petition under section 14 of PWDV Act, praying for directing both the parties to undergo counseling for reconciliation as the opposite party no. 1 is willing to resolve the matrimonial dispute amicably.

Copy served upon the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner who received the same with strong objection.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner is not willing to undergo counseling for reconciliation and that the filing of such petition by the opposite party no. 1 is just dilatory tactics and as such, prays for rejection of the instant petition.

Heard both sides.

Considered.

Considering the submission of Ld. Advocate of both the sides, this Court is inclined to reject the instant petition under section 14 of PWDV Act as the petitioner herself is not willing to undergo counseling for reconciliation.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands rejected at this stage.

Opposite party no. 1 is directed to file written objection and affidavit of assets and liabilities by the next date positively.

Fix 02.05.2025 for filing for written objection and affidavit of assets and liabilities positively by the opposite party no. 1 and S/R of opposite party no. 5 to 8 and exparte party no. 2 to 4.
