

Heard on the regular bail application filed by the accused Mandeep Singh. Applicant averred that the allegations of the FIR are totally false. No alleged offence has been committed by the accused/applicant. The accused/applicant is innocent person. Nothing has been recovered for the accused/applicant as alleged by the police. The accused/applicant is in Judicial Custody and no more required for investigation. It will take long time in completion of trial and no useful purpose can be served by detaining the accused/applicant in judicial custody for indefinite period. The accused/applicant undertakes that he will not hamper with the prosecution witnesses and temper the evidence. The accused/applicant is law abiding citizen. He has permanent abode, therefore there is no chance of his absconding. Accused/applicant undertakes to comply with all the conditions to be imposed by the Hon'ble Court. He averred that as his presence is no more required for the purposes of investigation, thus, he released on bail.

Notice of the bail application was given to the prosecution. Learned APP orally opposed the bail application but did not file any written reply.

Accused-applicant has been arrested for commission of offence under section 21-A/61/85 NDPS Act. Perusal of file as well as police record suggested that 5 grams of heroin got recovered from the accused including the polythene bag in which heroin was kept so the weight of heroin falls below 5 grams and this court has present to try the offence. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with a surety of the like amount. Further his bail is subject to the following conditions:-

1. He shall not jump over the bail or tamper with the complainant evidence nor shall try to win over the witnesses.
2. That He shall join investigation as and when required by the police.
3. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

Requisite bail bonds not furnished. Bail application stands disposed of. Papers be tagged.
