ORDER

Jyoti has filed this application seeking pre arrest bail in FIR
No.183, dated 24.9.2021, under sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471,120-B IPC,
Police Station City, Hoshiarpur.

2. As per the facts of the case, FIR was registered on the written
complaint bearing N0o.370, dated 24.9.2021 filed by Mrs.Jatinder Kaur-II,
Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur to the effect that Raman Batra accused
was granted bail in FIR No.145, dated 12.8.2021, under section 21-61-85 of
ND&PS Act, Police Station Haryana vide order dated 15.9.2021. On 24.9.2021,
bail/surety bonds in the sum of ₹ One Lac with two sureties in the like amount
were furnished, in which Surjit Singh son of Mahinder Singh, resident of
Village Bhatrana stood surety of Raman Batra. On checking the documents,

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Shri Mahesh Chander, Reader of the court informed that the photograph on Aadhar Card produced by the surety did not tally with his face. On enquiry the surety was unable to tell his name, parentage and address and on verification from the server, the Aadhar Card used by the accused was found to be forged and fabricated as no such Aadhar Card bearing the said number was in existence. The person whose photograph was affixed on the Aadhar card was already in custody in FIR No.177/2021, under sections 419,420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station City. The accused used Aadhar Card having No.266970007840 for furnishing surety bonds in the name of Surjit Singh, whereas Lambardar Paramjit and Jyoti daughter of Ashok Kumar identified the said accused/surety. When the court was enquiring about the name and address from accused Amit Kumar, the alleged Lambardar Paramjit Singh and Jyoti ran away from the court alongwith other persons. Accordingly a case under sections 419,420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC was ordered to be registered against Amit Kumar, Paramjit Singh and Jyoti in Police Station City.

3. The counsel for the applicant argued that she is falsely implicated in this case. It was the duty of Lambardar to identify the surety. She had no role to play in the same. She was merely asked to sign on the papers which she did. She is ready to join the investigation and will abide by the terms of bail order. Therefore, her anticipatory bail application may be allowed.

4. Bail application is opposed by the Addl. Public Prosecutor.

5. I have gone through the record. The present FIR has been registered on the written complaint of Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur regarding appearance of fake person to stand as surety in the name of Surjit Singh and as per the documents on record, the said surety bonds were witnessed by Jyoti the present applicant and Lambardar of village Bhatrana. It

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is a case of furnishing fake surety bonds for the release of accused who was involved in an ND&PS case. The allegations are serious. The applicant is yet to join the investigation. Considering the facts of the case, I do not find a fit case for anticipatory bail and the same is accordingly declined. Police file be returned with copy of the order. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
