On notice, Ld. Addl. PP has appeared for respondent-State.

Main file pending for 29.02.2020 put up by Ahlmad is perused. Heard on this application of applicant-accused moved for regular bail in this case.

2. Ld. Counsel for applicant submitted that latter has been falsely implicated qua alleged offence under section 29 of NDPS Act. Alleged contraband does not belong to him. Nothing has been recovered from him. He is in custody since 20.01.2020. Hence the prayer to admit him to regular bail.

3. Ld. Addl.P.P. opposed the prayer seeking dismissal of application in view of the nature of allegations.

4. Non-applicant/co-accused Gurcharan Singh allegedly was apprehended on 29.11.2019 and from him recovery of 400 tablets Clovidol-100 SR was effected. On his version the applicant was named as co-accused as supplier vide DDR No.30 dated 30.11.2019. Except for such version of co-accused, there is nothing before Investigating Agency so far to relate the alleged contraband with applicant. Latter is in custody since 20.01.2020. Co-accused Gurcharan Singh already has been released on bail by this Court. Disposal of challan will take considerable time. Applicant is not required for any investigation purposes. His culpability

will be decided in the regular trial. Therefore, without commenting on merits of the case, applicant-accused is admitted to regular bail on furnishing his personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds not furnished. Bail application file be attached with main file which be returned to Ahlmad for date fixed.
