ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application seeking bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. moved by applicant-accused Vimal Sahni in the above noted case.
2. Notice of the bail application was given to State of Punjab, upon which learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State has opposed bail application. Record perused.
3. Concisely stated, on 24.02.2023 in the area of Bheem Nagar Road, Qazi Mandi, Jalandhar, accused Sanam was apprehended by a police party headed by SI Arun Kumar;

From the search of accused Sanam, a black color bag containing 900 rams 'Ganja', which is a narcotic substance, was recovered without any licence or permit.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has vehemently contended that accused has been falsely implicated in the alleged crime by planting a false recovery. Accused is lingering in custody since 24.02.2023. So, he may be released on bail.

5. On the contrary, learned Addl. PP for the State requested for dismissal of bail application, keeping in view of the gravity of the crime.

6. Having considering the arguments of both the sides, in light of record available on the file, I have found that the alleged recovery of 900 grams of Ganja effected from the applicant-accused falls in the category of non-commercial quantity. The applicant/accused is lingering in custody since 24.02.2023. It will take time in conclusion of investigation. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the applicant-accused behind the bars indefinitely.

8. So, without commenting upon the merits of the case, applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court/Duty Judge subject to the conditions that she shall appear on each and every date of hearing; she shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and she shall not induce the prosecution witnesses; she shall surrender her passport in the Court. If she does not possess any

passport, then an affidavit in this respect be also furnished by applicant/accused.

9. The bail application stand allowed accordingly. Bail application file be tagged with the remand papers.
