**** First Anticipatory Bail application under Section 482 BNSS ****

ORDER:

Apprehending his arrest, the applicant has filed the instant
application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita,
2023 (in short '**BNSS**') for grant of anticipatory bail.

2. Notice of bail application was given to the State, pursuant
thereto, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of the State.
Record was requisitioned.

3. The statement of ASI Balwinder Kaur from Women Cell, SBS Nagar has been recorded wherein she stated that

“ Stated that one complaint bearing No.65-PTM dated 09.01.2016 moved by complainant Sunita Devi wife of Ashok Kumar, resident of village Kalar, PS Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar against applicant Surinder Kumar son of Diwan Chand, resident of village Kalar, PS Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar is pending at Women Cell SBS Nagar. No FIR has yet been registered pertaining to above-said complaint.”

4. No FIR has so far been registered against the applicant/accused and the matter is still pending with Women Cell, SBS Nagar, the apprehension of arrest on the part of applicant/accused is misplaced. As the complaint filed by complainant Sunita Devi against applicant-Surinder Kumar is pending, it is deemed fit that in the event of FIR being registered against applicant-accused, the Investigating Agency shall comply with the directions issued by Hon’ble High Court in case **“Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar” 2014 8 SCC 273** and shall issue adequate notice to applicant-accused, before his arrest, if so warranted under Section 35(3) of BNSS.

5. In view of it, the application for bail has become infructuous and the same is hereby dismissed. Police record be returned. File be consigned to record room.
