O R D E R

The present bail application has been entertained being an urgent hearing while performing duty in the period of closure of courts because of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Record perused. **Arguments have been heard** on regular bail of above referred applicant/ accused namely Gurjeet

Singh @ Jeeta in the above referred case, who is in custody since 26.08.2020.

3. In the present case, that on 26.08.2020, in the area of Sandhu Chatha Chowk, Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala, the present applicant/accused was apprehended with 05 kg Poppy Husk. The report of chemical examination is still not received.

4. To the aforesaid situation, the report of chemical examination is still not received and moreover, in view of the alleged recovery that even in the absence of report of chemical examination by considering the alleged recovery as a whole of poppy husk which is 5 kg that falls within the category of non-commercial quantity. Further, precautionary measures in wake of Pandemic Novel Coronavirus (Covid-19) have already been issued by our Hon'ble High Court, to consider urgent / bail matters. As such, the present bail application stands allowed and the applicant is hereby admitted on **regular bail**. Accused is directed to furnish personal bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/-with the conditions that applicant-accused will not tamper with the evidence; will attend the court on each and every date of hearing and will not leave India without prior permission of the court till the disposal of the trial.

5. Accordingly, the present bail application stands disposed off. Bail application be attached with the file of concerned FIR.
