1. Bail matter has been taken up through video conferencing from home keeping in view the situation arising due to outbreak of Novel Corona virus (COVID-19. Arguments heard through video conferencing.

2. My this order will dispose of application under section 439 of the CrPC submitted on behalf of applicant/ accused Aman alias Billa son of Bhuri.

3. Notice of bail application has been given to the State.

4. I have heard learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, and learned counsel for the applicant/ accused.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the state argued that accused Yuvraj Singh, Avinash Singh and accused/ applicant Aman alias Bila snatched the purse of complainant Gurmej Singh which contained Rs.14,500/-. An amount of Rs.4000/- was recovered from all the accused. All the accused forged the registration number plate bearing no. PB-35-F-5613 of the motor cycle Pulsar. They committed the offence under section 379-B, 411, 473 of IPC. The bail application should be dismissed.

6. On the other hand learned counsel for the accused/ applicant

argued that accused/ applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. The challan qua all the accused has been presented. The co-accused are already on bail. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. He be granted bail.

7. From the submissions of learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, learned counsel for the accused/ applicant and from the perusal of the record, it is clear that challan has been presented in the court and same is pending before this court. The accused/ applicant is in custody. The conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bar. As such accused/ applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Area/ Duty Magistrate subject to the condition that he will attend the court on each and every date of hearing, he will not leave the country without prior permission of the court; he will not influence the witnesses and in case of any misuse of concession of bail, both the accused as well as surety shall be liable for the consequences as per law. Copy of this order be sent to the Ilaqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate Pathankot for necessary compliance. Bail application file be tagged with the main trial.
