

State Vs Karamveer Singh

ORDER

Heard on the application for bail under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, moved by the accused/ applicant, namely Karamveer Singh @ Raja, in the case bearing FIR No. 72 dated 07.07.2024, under Section 115 (2), 127 (4), 140 (3), 351 (3), 318 (4)/ 61 (2), of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, PS Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

2. Vide order dated 07.08.2024, the accused/ applicant was granted interim anticipatory bail by this court, with direction to join the investigation.

3. As informed, he has complied with the direction.

4. Today, ASI Nachattar Singh has come present and has suffered a statement that the accused/ applicant has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for further investigation. In the light of above situation, interim order dated 07.08.2024 is made absolute and the application is allowed on the same terms and conditions and subject to the conditions as follows :-

1. the applicant/ accused shall make himself available for interrogation by the investigating officer/ competent police officer as and when required;
2. the applicant/ accused shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court to any police officer;
3. the applicant/ accused shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

4. the applicant/ accused shall attend the proceedings in accordance with the conditions of the bonds so executed under Chapter XXXIII of CrPC.
5. the applicant/ accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected;
6. the applicant/ accused shall not tamper with the evidence by any means;
7. the applicant/ accused shall appear before the trial court on each and every date of hearing unless his personal appearance is exempted.

5. In case of violation of any of the conditions so imposed upon the applicant/ accused, the investigating officer will be at liberty to file an appropriate application seeking cancellation of the bail granted to the applicant/ accused through the present order.

6. Needless to mention that anything discussed herein above shall have no bearing, whatsoever, upon the merits of the case and observations made herein above, if any, are solely for the purpose of disposal of the application in hand.
