ORDER:

1. Bail application put up before me being Duty Judge in view of order dated 30.3.2020 bearing No.2/SPL/RG/Misc. of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and order of Ld. District & Sessions Judge bearing endorsement No. 7239-7247/P2C dated 14/04/2020.
2. Police record produced. Present FIR was got registered by Krishan Lal with the allegations that petitioner obtained ₹ 5 Lacs from him for providing job to his son Anil Kumar in Railway Department or in Punjab National Bank but thereafter, neither he provided job to his son nor returned the amount.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for petitioner that the petitioner has compromised the matter with the complainant in the Mediation Centre and a report of Mediation Centre dated 07/03/2020 is on record. In compliance of above compromise, petitioner has already paid ₹ One Lac to complainant and he is ready to make the remaining payment of ₹ One Lac at the time of filing of quashing petition in Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner is ready to join investigation and to cooperate in the same, so till the disposal of present bail application, he may be

admitted to interim bail.

4. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor also admitted the fact that the parties have settled the matter in the Mediation Centre.

5. I have considered the arguments of learned counsel for petitioner and perused the record.

6. The parties have already compromised the matter. Keeping in view above facts and circumstances, petitioner is directed to join investigation on **24/04/2020** at 10:00 AM. In the event of his arrest, he will be admitted to interim bail on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer and subject to the fulfillment of the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Now police record be produced on **29/04/2020** for arguments.
