Record is fixed today for appearance and evidence before charge.

Ld. A.P.P is present.

The accused person, namely, **Krishnapada Dhara**, is present by filing hazira and also files a petition praying for pleading guilty on the ground stated therein as regards the offence punishable under Section 46A(C) Bengal Exercise Act (hereinafter referred to as B.E. Act). Copy served upon the Ld. A.P.P. Let it be taken on record.

In view of the petition so filed the record is taken up for charge hearing. Heard both sides at length. Considered,

The contents of the charge to the effect that on 24.07.2025 in an open place situated at Paliara, P.S-Penro, District-Howrah, S.I. of U.N. Pur Exercise circle arrested one **Krishnapada Dhara**, with one (01) Nylon bag containing twenty five (25) poly pouches @ 200 ml. each (approx) transparent liquid suspected to be illicit distilled liquor totalling 05 ltrs. On being asked he did not disclose his identity and also failed to show any authentic papers in support of 05 ltrs. unauthorized (01) Nylon bag containing twenty five (25) poly pouches @ 200 ml. each (approx) totalling 05 ltrs. and upon further inquiry the same was found to be purchased by you i.e. **Krishnapada Dhara** and thus you were in contravention of Section 18(1) of the Bengal Exercise Act and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 46A(C) B.E. Act, is read over and explained to the accused person to which he pleads guilty by saying “**AMI DOSHI**”.

Ld. A.P.P does not raise any objection. This Court accepts the plea of guilt. Accordingly, the accused person is hereby convicted for the offense punishable under Section 46A(C) B.E. Act and considering the fact that there is no previous criminal antecedent of this accused person this Court is of the view that the accused person may be all adequately punished by imposing a sentence of fine only without any sentence of imprisonment.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED.

that the accused, **Krishnapada Dhara**, is convicted and hereby sentenced to pay fine of Rs.700/- only for the offense punishable under Section 46A(C) B.E. Act., i.d., to suffer S.I for (05) five days only.

The case is disposed of accordingly.

The period of detention already undergone by this accused person in connection with this case may be set off in case he suffers imprisonment.

Seized articles be destroyed in accordance with law by the E/O.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the E/O of this case for his/her information and necessary compliance.
