

Complaint case 907 of 2025

Order dated 12.12.2025

Today is fixed for appearance.

Complainant has filed hazira.

Now the record is taken up for SA.

Hd. Ld. Advocate of the complainant.

Perused the statement of complainant U/S 200 Cr.P.C and other materials on record.

The complainant on solemn affirmation has only said that “I have filed this case against my wife Dola Dey @ Banani Dey, my daughter Poulami Chatterjee and my son in law Sourav Chatterjee. My wife is a strong believer of black magic and always under suspicion that everyone is plotting against her to cause some wrong to her. Due to that I am huge mental stress and physical distress as during the different black magic rituals deep dark smoke is created and I always feel suffocated by the same. She also keep on playing utensils throughout the night, so that I could not sleep properly. She has given all of our gold ornaments to a Tantrik and a criminal case has been initiated in the Howrah PS regarding that incident. On 26.11.2025 at around 8.30 a.m., I was going into my bed room to change my clothing, but suddenly my wife pushed me into my room and locked me from outside and throw away all my medicines and mobile phone and also called my daughter and son in law. After My daughter and son in law came to my house, they insisted of giving Rs. 25 lakh along with their respective shares in the property, so that they can get away from the fraud case, they are involved in. I have constantly helped my daughter and my grand child but I could not give Rs. 25 lakh to them to settle their case and due to that they continuously torturing me. After that they started abusing me in filthy language and cursed me to die as fast as possible. ”

Therefore, with these materials, this court is not prima facie satisfied regarding the case that the complainant has made out and regarding the issue of process against the accused person.

At this stage, this court is of the opinion that an enquiry is very much necessary to ascertain that whether there is sufficient ground for proceeding against the accused person for the alleged offence or not.

The Officer in Charge of Howrah PS is directed to conduct a thorough inquiry on the points aforesaid and to submit an enquiry report by the next date.
