**ORDER
(Delivered on 29.05.2026)**

(1) Heard on the application having been moved by accused/applicant Ravi @ Atul seeking grant of concession of regular bail in terms of provisions Under Section 483 BNSS in FIR No. 182 dated 16.04.2026 Under Sections 112(2), 310(4) BNS, PS City Faridkot.

(2) As per averments made in the application, false case has been registered against accused/applicant on false and frivolous allegations. He has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has to be recovered from him. He has nothing to do with present FIR. He is innocent and had been wrongly and illegally implicated in this case. The witnesses are interested in prosecution, so there is no question of tampering with their evidence. Lastly, request is made for grant of regular bail to the accused/ applicant.

(3) Pursuant to the notice given to the State, the learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State contested the claim of the applicant with the plea that allegations leveled against the applicant are serious in nature and in the light of the facts and circumstances of the case, the applicant does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

(4) I have given thoughtful consideration to the respective contentions of both sides and have gone through the record on the file. Arguments have been made ad-verbatim.

(5) Brief facts of the present case as emanating from the record are that on 16.04.2026, ASI Gurjeet Singh along with other police officials, laptop and printer, on private vehicle, in connection with patrolling and checking of suspicious persons, was present at Sadiq Chowk, where at about 07.30 P.M, he received a secret information that Kuldeep Singh, Sukhwinder Singh @ Jugnu, Manpreet Singh @ Mani, Mangal Singh @ Manga and Ravi, are habitual of committing dacoities. They were planning to commit dacoity while hiding themselves near the bathrooms situated near gate of grain market, on the road leads from Sadiq Chowk to Post Office and they were armed with deadly weapons Finding information reliable and trustworthy, FIR was registered under Sections 112/310(4)BNS. Accused/ applicant along with co-accused were arrested and three swords, one iron 'kaapa' and one wooden baton were recovered from them.

(6) During the pendency of bail application, ASI Sarabjit Singh No. 839/FDK Posted at PS City-II Faridkot suffered a statement that present case was registered on 16.04.2026, on the basis of secret information received by IO ASI Gurjit Singh against accused/ applicant and his co-accused. Accused made preparation to commit dacoity. Accused/ applicant is in custody since 16.4.2026. From possession of accused persons, three 'kirpans', one 'kaapa' and one wooden stick (sota) were recovered. Accused/ applicant was found in possession of wooden stick (sota). Except present FIR, no other

FIR has been registered against accused/ applicant.

(7) Accused/ applicant is in custody since 16.04.2026. He has already spent a substantial period behind bar in this case. Presentation of challan and the conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served in keeping the applicant behind the bar for indefinite period, rather it will be a burden on State exchequer. Resultantly, the application is allowed without making any comments upon the merits of the case and the applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot. The bail order is subject to the conditions, as follows :-

1. that the applicant shall attend in accordance with the condition of the bond;
2. that the applicant shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused;
3. that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer; and
4. that the applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.

Copy of this order be sent to learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot. Police record be returned, immediately. Bail application file be consigned to the record-room.
