None has appeared on behalf of Plaintiff since morning despite repeated calls.

The present suit is for recovery.

It is pertinent to mention that Order 7 Rule 11 (f) CPC states that the plaint **shall** be rejected “*where the plaintiff fails to comply with provisions of Rule 9*”. Rule 9 of Order 7 CPC stipulates the procedure on admitting the plaint: “*Where the court orders that the summons be served on the defendants in the manner provided in Rule 9 of Order V, it will direct the plaintiff to present as many copies of the plaint on plain paper as there are defendants within seven days from the date of such order along with requisite fee for service of summons on the defendants.*”

The “requisite fee” referred to above is the Process Fee (PF). Record reflects that the Plaintiff has neither filed PF nor copies of plaint, and, as such, has not complied with the order of this Court despite availing repeated opportunities.

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**The plaint, therefore, stands rejected in view of
Order 7 Rule 11 (f) CPC read with Order 7 Rule 9 CPC.**
