Reply under the signature of SI Anuj Kumar forwarded by SHO PS Patel Nagar is filed. Upon going through the same it is found that the reply is nothing but reiteration of the reply filed on 11.04.2026. No date is mention in the reply filed today when SHO PS Patel Nagar came to know that the inspected premises does not situate within jurisdiction of PS Patel Nagar.

In the present matter a complaint stated to be filed to PS Patel Nagar on 12.05.2023 alleging the theft of electricity detected during the inspection conducted on 30.08.2022 at premises no. H-16/686, ground floor, Gali no. 12, Bapa Nagar, Karol Bagh, Delhi-05. The representation was made by way of mail on 13.08.2024 before DCP, Central as no action on the complaint was taken by the police. No action was taken by the office of DCP, Central as such complainant has approached this Court and has filed the criminal complaint along with one application u/s 175 (3) BNSS.

Vide order dated 03.01.2026, report was called from SHO PS Patel Nagar about receiving the complaint dated

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12.05.2023 and the action taken on it, if any. On 11.04.2026, report was received intimating that the premises/address is situated within jurisdiction of PS Prasad Nagar.

The law empowers police to take action on a complaint disclosing cognizable offence irrespective of the jurisdiction of a particular police station. The court has received the response from the office of Ld. Commissioner of Police about the instructions issued to take the proper action on such complaints, apprising it that office of Joint Commissioner, Central Range has issued circulars directing SHOs to take action upon the complaints filed by the DISCOMS.

The facts of the case disclose that the directions of the office of Joint Commissioner, Central Range have been disregarded in present matter.

Considering the facts, the facts are brought into the notice of Joint Commissioner, Central Range seeking his assistance in the matter as the reason for not taking the requisite action on the complaint due to jurisdiction is not valid as per law.
