

Common order below exhibit No.1 and 82 in
Special Civil Suit No.446/2012.

1] Both the parties have filed joint pursis stating that the matter between them is compromised and consent terms are framed accordingly. Hence, it is prayed for compromise decree. Plaintiff has prayed for withdrawal of the suit. Perusal of papers show that the matter was sent for mediation. Mediation report exhibit 83 is received that the matter between the parties is settled and they have filed consent terms accordingly.

2] Learned Counsel for both the parties have identified them. They have submitted before the Court that they have compromised their issues and have requested for compromise decree. They admitted the contents in the pursis to be true and correct. I am satisfied that the parties have compromised their matter voluntarily and have framed the consent terms. The compromise pursis is therefore verified, read and recorded. In view of the compromise pursis and consent terms the suit deserves to be disposed of. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) Suit stands disposed of in view of compromise pursis and consent terms.
- 2) Compromise decree be drawn up accordingly.
- 3) Court fee be refunded as per rules.
