O R D E R:-

This order of mine shall decide this application for pre-arrest bail under section 482 BNSS, filed in the above noted FIR on behalf of applicant, on the allegations that he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. No offence is made out against the

applicants/accused. Applicants/accused are shown to be empty handed and are alleged to have damaged the Car with bricks and have caused simple injuries to Aroor Singh, father-in-law of complainant, whereas, in fact they have never participated in the occurrence. All the offences are bailable except offence 452 IPC. Their custodial interrogation is not required and they are ready to join the investigation. Hence, it is prayed that the application be allowed and applicant be given the concession of pre-arrest bail.

2. Notice of bail application was issued to State and Sh. Dalip Kumar, Learned Public Prosecutor put in appearance on behalf of State. Record has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard arguments of learned counsel for applicant and learned Public Prosecutor for State and have gone through the record.

4. As per report of filing branch clerk, no bail application filed by applicant/accused is pending in the Hon'ble High Court. He has attached on record copy of report downloaded from the website of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. Allegations against the applicants/accused and others are that on 21.05.2024 at about 6:00 PM, complainant, Surjit Singh, Davinder Singh were present at house of complainant, Mukhtiar Singh armed with Kapa, Balwinder Singh gandasi, Tarsem Singh dang, Dilbag

Singh dang, Sukhdev Singh dang, Kamaljit Singh baseball, Manjit Singh kirpan, Munish, Mindo Bai and Gagandeep Kaur tress passed into their house while abusing. Complainant and her husband alongwith her brothers were sitting on the cots. Mukhtiar Singh raised lalkara that today they should not be spared. Mukhtiar Singh gave a kapa blow on the back side of head with reverse side. Balwinder Singh gave reverse gandasi blow in her head and when her brothers came forward, Munish gave Tangli blow on the hand of Surjit Singh, Tarsem Singh gave dang blow on her left thumb, Kamaljit Singh gave baseball blow on her left shoulder. Then Mangal Singh came forward. Sukhdev Singh gave dang blow in his waist. Complainant fell down on the cot while bleeding from the head and accused gave beatings to Surjit Singh and Davinder Singh and husband of complainant and had broken windows of Alto Car. Applicant Mindo Bai and Gagandeep Kaur pelted stones and brick bats and they had pelted stones towards Aroor Singh and all the accused wrongly confined them and caused injuries on their persons.

6. All the offences except offence under section 452 IPC are bailable. Offence under section 452 IPC is punishable with seven years of imprisonment. Applicants/accused are females. No notice as required under section 35 of BNSS has been served upon the

applicants/accused. Custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused is not required.

7. Considering all these facts, applicants/accused are directed to join investigation. In case they are required to be arrested, they be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. The applicants shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

8. Now file be put up on 02.08.2024.
