**ORDER:**

1. This order of mine will dispose of an application for regular bail moved by accused-applicant Gagandeep Singh in case FIR No.148 of 2022 u/s. 392,34,201 IPC 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act, PS Katnu Nangal, on the averments that applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated. Applicant is in custody since 4.3.2023. Challan has already been presented in the court but the prosecution has failed to conclude evidence. No useful purpose will be served by further detaining the accused behind bars. Conclusion of trial will take long time.

2. Notice of this bail application was given to the State, upon which, learned Additional PP for the State appeared and contested the same. Investigating Officer ASI Rajinder Singh appeared alongwith police record and his statement was recorded.

3. I have heard ld.counsel for the applicant-accused, ld. Addl.PP for the State and gone through the record very carefully.

4. Learned counsel for accused-applicant pressed for grant of bail on the ground that accused-applicant has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. Accused-applicant is in custody since his arrest on 4.3.2023. Challan has already been presented in the court but the prosecution has failed to conclude evidence. Applicant is no more required for further investigation. Conclusion of trial will take considerable time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused-applicant in custody.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional PP has refuted above contentions on the ground that accused-applicant alongwith co-accused has committed heinous offence and prayed for dismissal of the bail application of applicant-accused.

6. Perusal of the investigation record reveals the fact that the present case was registered on the written complaint moved by complainant Rohin Babbar, of Punjab National Bank, Kathu Nangal, Amritsar, that on 19.12.2022 at about 10.55 AM two persons having muffled faces entered into bank and at gun point robbed Rs.17,72,805/- from the bank cashier and fled away from the spot. During the investigation of case FIR NO. 29/2023, u/s 392 IPC, P.S.25 Arms Act,

P.S.Cantonment accused Laljit Singh and Gagandeep Singh made disclosure statement regarding committing of robbery of this case. Accordingly accused Lajjit Singh and Gagandeep Singh were arrested on 4.3.2023. Accused Laljit Singh got recovered Rs.4 Lakh out of the robbed amount. Accused-applicant Gagandeep Singh is in custody in this case since 4.3.2023.

ASI Rajinder Kumar has brought the record and made statement that allegations against accused-applicant are that he alongwith his co-accused committed robbery of Rs.17,72,805/- from the bank. Accused Gagandeep Singh is in custody since 4.3.2023. First bail application u/s 439 Cr.P.C filed by accused-applicant Gagandeep Singh was dismissed vide order 11.7.2023. No new ground is made out to grant bail to the accused-applicant. So, the allegations against the accused/applicant are grave and serious in nature.

7. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances, gravity of offence and seriousness of the allegations, this Court is of considered view that accused-applicant does not deserve concession of bail. If accused/applicant is released on bail, then he may create hindrance in the trial and may induce and threat the witnesses. Consequently, present bail application for grant of regular bail moved by accused-applicant Gagandeep Singh, is hereby dismissed. Police record be returned. Record of bail application be consigned to the record room.
