ORDER :-

1. This order of mine shall dispose of **regular bail application** filed

on behalf of **Mani Singh (bail-applicant)** in the above noted FIR.

2. **Notice** of the application was issued to learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State assisted by learned counsel for bail-applicant and the record has been requisitioned and perused.

3. From the record, it comes out to surface that FIR no. 6 dated 08.01.2020, U/s 458, 323, 324/148/149 IPC and Section 325/326/460, 201 IPC was added later on at P.S Moonak, at the instance of complainant against Sukhwinder Singh, Simranjit Singh, Pritam Singh, Manjit Singh. The complainant has levelled allegations that on 07.01.2020 at about 5.00 P.M, since it was chilling winter evening, therefore, Sandeep Singh along-with other persons had come to Panchayti Shed for warming their hands, as there was bonfire installed. Pritam Singh and Sukhwinder Singh also came there. The moment Pritam Singh and Sukhwinder Singh had landed there, they started using filthy abuse to Pritam Singh (father) of complainant and doused bonfire. On this Sandeep Singh (brother) of complainant stopped Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukhu to not douse bonfire, however, there was argumentation between Sandeep Singh and Sukhwinder Singh, however, they were intervened and were asked to leave to their houses. At about 6.30 P.M, Sukhwinder Singh @ Sukho armed with 'kirpan', along-with Pritam Singh (father) (son) of Surta Singh, armed with 'gandasa', Simranjit Singh @ Simmi (brother), Manjit Kaur (mother) armed with 'kirch' along-with 6/7 persons, who were also armed with 'kirpan' and 'sotis', had forcibly entered into the house of

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complainant. Pritam Singh raised 'lalkara' to catch hold of family members of complainant and be taught lesson for argumentation with Sandeep Singh. Meantime, Sukhwinder Singh gave 'kirpan' blow on the head of complainant, which was tried to be warded off by him by raising his left hand, therefore, 'kirpan' blow hit on left hand small finger. Simranjit Singh @ Simmi gave kirpan blow on the head of complainant, which hit on the left side of fore-head of complainant. The complainant fell down. When the complainant was lying down on the ground, Pritam Singh gave 'gandasa' blow from reverse side, which hit little above left side of waist of the complainant. An unidentified person gave 'soti' blow, which was tried to be warded off by the complainant by raising his right hand, therefore, it hit right hand thumb. When Budh Singh (father) came forward to rescue complainant, at that time, Manjit Kaur gave 'kirch' blow on the abdomen of Budh Singh, due to which, he fell down, however, it did not cause any harm. When Budh Singh was lying down on the ground, unidentified person gave 'dang' blow, little below right elbow. An another unidentified person has given 'dang' blow behind left shoulder of Budh Singh. Pritam Singh gave 'gandasa' blow to Budh Singh hitting on his left arm elbow. All the assailants then whisked away from spot, when the complainant has raised an alarm.

4. It is observed that all the accused having ganged up and inflicted grievous injuries with deadly weapons, on the person of complainant and Budh Singh (father) of complainant by entering their house at night time. Serious

allegations have been levelled against the assailants. The bail application filed on behalf of Prita Singh, Sukhwinder Singh, Simranjit Singh @ Simmi (co-accused) was dismissed by the under-signed vide common order dated 19.05.2020. Furthermore, the bail application filed on behalf of Akshay Kumar and Manjit Kaur (co-accused) has been dismissed by the Court of Smt. Poonam Bansal, vide order dated 10.02.2020. The regular bail application of Lakwhinder Singh (co-accused) was dismissed by the Court of Sh. Sham Lal, Id. Addl. Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide order dated 11.02.2020. Therefore, on the basis of equity, I do not deem this case fit, where the bail-applicant is entitled to regular bail at this stage.

5. On the basis of discussion made by me in the preceding paragraphs of the order, present regular bail application filed on behalf of bail-applicant stands **dismissed**.

No observation made while deciding the bail application shall affect the merits of the case.

Police record be returned.

The bail application is ordered to be put up before the concerned for the purpose of consignment.
