Application for bail U/s 438(i) of Code of Criminal Procedure

FIR No. 232 dated 09.06.2023,
Under Sections 454, 380, 411 of IPC,
Police Station City Ferozepur.

O R D E R:-

This order of mine shall decide this application for pre-arrest bail under section 438 of Cr.P.C., filed in the above noted FIR on behalf of applicants, on the allegations that they are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case. They are not named in the FIR. Alleged recovery has already been effected from co-accused Sapna etc. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants/accused. They are females. Applicants/accused are ready to join investigation. Their custodial interrogation is not required. Hence, it is prayed that the application be allowed and applicants be given the concession of pre-arrest bail.

2. Notice of bail application was issued to State and Sh. Dalip Kumar, Learned Public Prosecutor put in appearance on behalf of State. Sh. N.S.Dhillon Advocate also put in appearance on behalf of complainant. Record has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard arguments of learned counsel for applicants and learned Public Prosecutor for State, assisted by learned counsel for complainant and have gone through the record.

4. As per report of filing branch clerk, no bail application filed by applicants/accused is pending in the Hon'ble High Court. He has attached on record copy of report downloaded from the website of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

5. The case has been registered against Hina and 15/20 unidentified women, on the statement of Sanjiv Kapur that on 02.06.2023, at about 4:20 PM, he received a phone call from his known person that 15/20 ladies are standing in front of his godown and locks of his godown are broken and he apprehends that those ladies are committing theft of some objects from the godown. At this, complainant reached at his godown and found that ladies have already left and when he checked the godown, he found that 20 rolls of V-Guard cable 4 mm, 20 rolls of Relaxo cable 20 mm, 25 rolls of JK cable 2.5 mm, 4 rolls of Uflex cable 10 mm, 50 rolls of Jecon cable 1.5 mm, about 100 pieces of ceiling fans have been stolen from his godown and he kept on searching for those ladies and now he has come to know that one Hina of Faridkot has formed a gang of ladies and in case they are arrested, then his stolen articles can be recovered.

6. Initially, applicants/accused have not been named in the FIR and they were named as accused in supplementary statement of complainant on the ground that CCTV camera is installed near the place of occurrence and after going through the footage, complainant has named the applicants as accused. Investigating Agency has not taken into police possession the record of that CCTV footage till date. Offences are punishable upto 7 years of imprisonment. No notice as required under section 41-A of Cr.P.C. has been served upon the applicants/accused. Considering all these facts, applicants/accused are directed to join investigation. In case they are required to be arrested, they be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. The applicants shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

7. Now file be put up on 18.07.2023.
