**Bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C.**

**ORDER**

This order of mine shall dispose of a bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. filed by accused-applicant Gurpal Singh @ Pal seeking anticipatory bail in the above said FIR, which was registered on the statement of Amritpal Singh, on the allegations that on 13.08.2019 at about 12.00 noon, he was going to his fields to take a round on his motorcycle and in the way Kiranpal Singh son of Joginder Singh resident of Khosa Kotla whose fields also fell on the same way met him and he sat on his motorcycle. He further alleged that when they reached parallel to the fields of Mohinder Singh son of Sajjan Singh, resident of Khosa Kotla,

whose motor was at a distance of one kilometer from the road, two persons having cut their hairs were seen sitting on the motor of Mohinder Singh, upon which he had a doubt that those persons were cutting the wires of motor, because earlier some wires were stolen on this side. He further alleged that when he along with Kiranpal Singh went towards those persons, they ran away from the spot along with wires, but they were earlier known to them, out of whom one was Lovepreet Singh @ Gaggi son of Kulwant Singh son of Lachhman Singh and other was Gurpal Singh alias Pal son of Billu Singh, resident of Village Khosa Randhir and they tried to chase them, but they could not be traced.

2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant argued that accused-applicant was quite innocent and accused-applicant was falsely involved in said case. He argued that said case was registered only due to political motivation and it was prayed that accused-applicant may be released on bail.

3. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP hotly contested the bail application.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the accused-applicant as Ld. Addl. PP for the State and perused the record.

5. Perusal of the police file shows that co-accused Lovepreet Singh has already been arrested by the police on 15.08.2019 and 20 feet of stolen wires has been recovered from him. Nothing more is to be recovered from the accused-applicant. Therefore his custodial interrogation

is not necessary. Consequently, the present bail application is allowed provided that the accused-applicant shall join investigation within 7 days. Investigating officer/Arresting Officer/SHO is directed to release the applicant on bail in the event of his arrest, in the present case to his satisfaction, subject to the provisions of section 438(2) Cr.P.C. This file be consigned to the record room.
