ORDER:

1. Vide this order I intend to dispose of this bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS by applicant/accused Gagandeep Singh @ Gaggu, in the afore mentioned case.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and on requisition, police record was produced, which has been perused.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that the applicant has falsely been implicated in this case and he was not involved in any such incident. The applicant was not even present at the time and place of alleged occurrence and he never inflicted injuries to the complainant. The entire version given in the FIR is false and vague in nature. The applicant is in custody since long. Challan has already been

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presented and conclusion of trial would take considerable time, as such, he may be granted regular bail.

4. On the other hand, the learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that bail-applicant along with his co-accused has committed heinous offence and so, this bail application deserves to be dismissed.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned Addl.PP for the State and have gone through the material on record.

6. This case was registered on the statement of complainant Himmat Rai, wherein he got recorded that he along with his friends Narinder Kumar, Ajay, Sanju, Vishal and Ankush had gone to market, situated opposite to Dadi Poti Park, Bathinda, for some work. Thereafter, they were going towards Basant Vihar through the streets via Chandsar Basti. On the way to Chandsar Basti, two young persons, namely Jaspreet Singh @ Jassi and Sukhe, passed bad remarks to them which led to an altercation with those persons.

7. The complainant further alleged that at about 8.30 p.m., he and his companions reached in Street no. 4 of Basant Vihar, Bathinda, where accused Sukhe along with co-accused Jassi and 10/12 unknown persons, armed with rods, Kirpans and other lethal weapons, came on 4-5 motorcycles and way laid them. The persons started beating him and his friend Narinder Kumar. Among those assailants, there was one Jaspreet Singh @ Jassi, with whom they had heated exchange. Accused Jaspreet

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Singh Jaspreet Singh gave Kirpan blow, with an intention to kill him, and the said blow hit at the rear side of his head. Following this Jaspreet Singh blurted out, Sukhe, Vikram, Giani, Gole, Gaggu, let us teach a lesson to complainant party for entering into altercation with them. Then Bikram, who was accompanying accused Jassi, gave Kirpan blow to the complainant, with intention to kill him and the blow hit below knee of his right leg. When the complainant tried to run away, co-accused Lovepreet Giani gave blow of rod on his below his knee, due to which he fell down. While the complainant was lying on the ground, one unknown boy gave rod blow on his left leg and other unknown boys/assailants gave beatings to him with sticks and other lethal weapons and he received multiple injuries. Above said Sukhe along with his associates namely Gola and Gaggu (**applicant**) inflicted injuries to his friend Narinder Kumar, with Kirpan, Rods and other deadly weapons with intention to kill him. On raising alarm by complainant and his friends, the above assailants fled away from the spot.

8. In the incident in question, complainant Himmat Rai and his friend Narinder Kumar were inflicted injuries. As per medical record, complainant Himmat Rai received four injuries, whereas total six injuries were reported on the person of Narinder Kumar. There are accusations that applicant/accused Gaggu along with co-accused Sukhe and Gola inflicted injuries to associates of complainant namely Narinder Kumar, with their weapons. All the injuries, including head injury, stated to be

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result of use of blunt weapon/s, on the person of complainant Himmat Rai were opined to be simple in nature. Out of six injuries of injured Narinder Kumar, three of the injuries were declared to be grievous in nature, but, no specific injury is attributed the applicant. More so, none of the injuries of above said two injured, has been declared to be dangerous to life.

9. The applicant is in custody since 11.10.2025. Challan has already been presented and conclusion of trial would take considerable time. The culpability of the offence is yet to be ascertained during the course of trial. No useful purpose is going to be served by further incarceration of the applicant as the same would amount to putting an additional burden on the State exchequer.

10. Hence, this bail application is allowed and applicant/accused is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing of bail/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Area/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:

- a) That accused/applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence and will not offer any threat, promise or inducement, directly or indirectly to any of the person acquainted with the facts of the case, dissuading him from disclosing the same to the court/ investigating agency; and
- b) That accused/applicant will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the court.
- c) That accused/applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing, subject to the order of exemption, otherwise, trial court is at liberty to cancel the bail order.

11. Copy of the order be sent the concerned court for necessary compliance.

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12. Ahlmad is also directed to send copy of this order through e-mail to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, forthwith, for necessary information as well as conveying the same to the bail applicant.

13. Papers be annexed with main trial case file.
