

Order No. 24 Dated: 22.07.2025

Today is fixed for filing answer by the defendants to the interrogatory, hearing of application u/O 1 R 10 (2), submission of commission report.

Plaintiff filed hazira along with a petition for extension of ad interim order of injunction. Plaintiff also filed one application u/O 1 R 10(2).

Defendant Nos. 1 & 2 filed hazira.

Both the application under Order 1 Rule 10 (2) dated 22.05.2024 and 22.07.2025 which are taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff submitted that the persons mentioned in the schedule of petition are the necessary party to the suit and their names were provided by the defendants in their answer to the interrogatory. So, proper adjudication of the suit it is necessary that names of the parties mentioned in the schedule be added as parties to the suit.

Ld. Advocate for the defendant gave consent.

On perusal of the record it appears to the Court that the names of the persons mentioned in the schedule of the petitions are the necessary parties to the suit and they should be impleaded as necessary parties for proper and fair adjudication of the suit. So, this Court finds no impediment in allowing this application and allows the names of the persons mentioned in the schedule of the petition to be impleaded as the parties to the suit as the defendants.

Hence it is

Ordered

That the petitions dated 22.05.2024 and 22.07.2025, u/Or 1 Rule 10(2) filed by the plaintiffs are hereby allowed on contest without any order as to cost and disposed of.

The name of the parties be added as defendant.

Plaintiff is directed to file the amended plaint.

Ld. Advocate Commissioner filed the commission report be kept with the record.

Defendant Nos. 3, 4 & 5 duly received the summon but failed to appear so the the suit will proceed ex parte against defendant Nos. 3, 4 & 5.

Fixing 04.11.2025 for hearing of injunction application, steps by the plaintiff on the added defendants.

Ad interim is extended till date.
