ORDER:

1 This common order will dispose off the above mentioned two bail applications, i.e. one filed by Charanjit Singh son of Jaspal Singh and second filed by Manpreet Singh son of Jodh Singh, both for grant of regular bail, arising out of one FIR, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. and notices of the same were given to the State.

2. Heard. The record reveals that FIR No.123 dated 02.07.2021, under Sections 406/420/489-D,489-C,489-E of the Indian Penal Code, was registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala, against Pargat Singh son of Bhajan Singh and one Harpreet Kaur @ Preeti wife of Harwinder Singh, on the allegations that on 02.07.2021, ASI Balbir Singh alongwith other police officials, in connection with patrolling duty and in search of bad elements, were present at Bus Stand, Subhanpur, where

secret information was received by ASI Balbir Singh that one Car bearing registration No. PB-10-DS-3700 mark Skoda of white colour, which is driven by Pargat Singh son of Bhajan Singh, resident of Rajewal, P.S.Sadar, Khana and he is accompanied with one Harpreet Kaur @ Preeti wife of Harwinder Singh and the above mentioned persons had been cheating the public at large by stating that they can double their amounts and had also counterfeiting the currency notes and had been selling the same and today they are coming from Nadala towards Subhanpur and even the above mentioned persons have formed a gang and if Nakabandi be held, the above mentioned persons can be caught red handed. Further information was also received that above mentioned persons had also been operating in different states and had also been cheating the public in other states. After sometime, one Car bearing registration No. PB-10 DS 3700 was seen coming and on this ASI Balbir Singh got stopped the above mentioned car and the driver of the Car disclosed his name as Pargat Singh son of Bhajan Singh and to the next seat of the driver, one lady was seen sitting and she disclosed her name as Harpreet Kaur @ Preeti. Further, it is the prosecution story that during search of the car, from its dicky, one bottle of weak IODINE solution IP, one bottle of bleaching powder weighing 20 grams, Rs.7500/- currency notes, Rs.2000/- counterfeit currency notes, 4 packets of paper chemical etc., were recovered. The above mentioned articles were taken into police possession, vide separate recovery memo. Thus, on the basis of these facts, the present case was registered. Accused Pargat Singh and Harpreet

Kaur @ Preeti were arrested, accordingly. The present applicants have been nominated as accused on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Binder Pal Kaur on 07.07.2021.

3. Ld. Counsel for the applicants has simply stated before this Court that applicants are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of confessional statement, suffered by co-accused Binder Pal Kaur on 07.07.2021. It was further submitted that applicants have got nothing to do with the counterfeit currency notes or any other article (s). It was further submitted that in fact false recovery has been shown against the applicants. In the end, it was submitted that applicants are innocent and are in lockup for the last more than one month, as such, the applicants be given the concession of regular bail.

4. On hearing these submissions of the counsel for the applicants, record reveals that non applicant Binder Pal Kaur was arrested and she suffered disclosure statement on 07.07.2021 that even the present applicants and others had been supporting her regarding making of counterfeit currency notes and accordingly, the present applicants were nominated as accused in the present case. Further record reveals that applicant Manpreet Singh was arrested alongwith Car bearing registration No.CH01-AP-0252 mark XUV and from its dicky, one bottle of chemical and one packet of chemical powder, Rs.1,50,000/- currency notes of the denomination of Rs.500/- each, 25 notes of the denomination of Rs.2000/- each (fake) i.e. totalling Rs.50,000/- were recovered from him, whereas from co- applicant one packet of chemical paper, white paper, was

recovered from him, which was kept by co- applicant Charanjit Singh in his Car bearing registration No. PB09-S 4904, when he was arrested on 02.07.2021 and these articles were meant for printing counterfeit currency notes.

5. So, since there are serious allegations against the present applicants that they were found in possession of counterfeit currency notes and were also found in possession of chemical powder alongwith papers for printing the counterfeit currency notes, as such, this Court in the given circumstances feels that applicants do not deserve the concession of regular bail. A copy of this order be placed in the connected file titled as "Manpreet Singh Vs. State of Punjab." Police record be returned. The files of bail application be consigned to the record room.
