

Title Suit 109 of 2025

Order No. 03 Dated:30.07.2025

Today the record has been placed by way of a put up petition along with a petition under Order 6 Rule 17 of CPC.

The record is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff submitted that due to some typographical error some fact has not been mentioned in the plaint. It is merely a typographical error and not intentional. If it is not corrected then the real controversy in dispute will not be determined. This amendment will not change the nature, character and cause of action of the suit. The amendment proposed is formal in nature.

Hence the plaintiff prays for amendment of the plaint as per the schedule mentioned in the petition.

After perusal of the record and the petition it is seen that the proposed amendment is very much formal in nature and if it is incorporated it will not change the nature and character of the suit.

Thus, considering the nature of the amendment, the stage of the instant suit and to determine the real question in controversy between the parties and also for the ends of justice the amendment sought for should be allowed. So, this Court is inclined to allow the amendment of the plaint as per the schedule mentioned in the petition.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the petition U/O 6 Rule 17 and the petition u/S 151 be and the same are hereby allowed and disposed of on contest without any cost. The plaintiff is allowed to amend the plaint as per the schedule of the present petition. The plaintiff is also directed to file the amended plaint and the injunction application within 14 days accordingly.
